

TORIS VALIDATION: SUMMARY OF RESOURCES

INTRODUCTION

Nearly every state and territory is in the process of planning, piloting, or implementing a tiered Quality Rating and Improvement System (TQRIS) to evaluate the levels of quality of early learning and development programs, inform decision-making to improve the programs, and educate families about the quality of the programs. Additionally, each grantee of the Race to the Top - Early Learning Challenge (RTT-ELC) competition is required to implement a TQRIS.

Many states are also developing TQRIS validation strategies to ensure that program standards accurately reflect differential levels of program quality and to support the effective implementation and ongoing maintenance of the state's early learning and development system. RTT-ELC grantee states are required to submit their TQRIS validation plans to the U.S. Department of Education and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for review and comment.

The purpose of this document is to provide a summary of resources that all states and territories may consult for guidance when making decisions with regard to the validation of their TQRIS. These resources include general resources, published reports on QRIS validation best practices, and recent research work conducted in multiple states.
